LADOT STRATEGIC PLAN UPDATE

Chelsea advised on LADOT's TRANSTAT process as part of its Strategic Plan Update that focuses on equity, health and safety, economic growth, sustainability, and responding to Covid-19 while positioning the department for long term growth. Specifically, she developed a dashboard to build accountability and transparency, and support performance management. The tool tracks the agency's progress on goals pertaining to internal development, social equity, health & safety, sustainability, economic growth and COVID-19 response among others.

LADOT TAXI/PTV STUDY
